Upon registration, these rules are yours. Their purpose is to provide safety for everyone, and to promote harmonious relationships with your neighbours and your environment.

RULES FOR CAMPING RIVIÈRE-OUELLE.

1.0 Access and circulation

- 1.1 The camper must strictly obey the directives indicated on the traffic signs. Unless posted otherwise, the maximum speed is 10 km/h.
- 1.2 The camper must obligatorily park his vehicle on his campsite or in the identified parking areas. It is strictly forbidden to park along the roads or any other prohibited area.
- 1.3 Motorcycle owners will only use their vehicles to enter and leave the campsite. The other types of two wheeled motorized-vehicles as well as all-terrain vehicles are not allowed on the campground.
- 1.4 It is forbidden to ride a bike outside posted hours on campground.
- 1.5 No motor vehicle traffic is authorized on the campground between 11 :00 p.m. and 7 :00 a.m. For this purpose, the barrier to campground is closed during the hours mentioned above.
- 1.6 Motorists, cyclists and pedestrians must use the identified roads and alleys for circulation and not pass through other peoples campsite.
- 1.7 No dangerous descent is allowed in the hills. The direction reserves the right to confiscate any wheeled vehicle from any offender for a duration that it judges appropriate in regard to the gravity of the offence and its repetitive nature or not, and this, subject to all the other campground's rules.

2.0 Tranquillité

- 2.1 Excessive noise will not be tolerated at any time, day or night.
- 2.2 Quiet hours are from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- 2.3 Games must be played in the places reserved for this purpose.
- 2.4 The visitors must register themselves at the office and pay the entrance fee. They must leave the campground before 11:00 p.m. Otherwise, they must inform the office of any changes.

2.5 While pets are permitted on the campground, they must be kept on a leash at all times. The owners are responsible for picking up messes made by pets. No pets will be allowed in public buildings or at the swimming pool. No aggressive animals are tolerated on the campground.

2.6 Any camper must have, at all times, a respectful language and a reasonable behaviour. Visitors are required to do the same.

2.7 No loitering is allowed at the office, at the convenience store and in the service building.

2.8 Any trade or soliciting is forbidden on the campground unless otherwise authorized by the direction.

2.9 Weapons of any kinds, such as guns, rifles, bows, firecrackers, and fireworks are strictly forbidden.

3.0 Respect of the environment

3.3 Campers must keep their garbage in appropriate garbage bags. All waste must be secured in plastic bags and put into the garbage bins.

3.4 It is forbidden to cut, even slightly, or damage trees on the campground.

3.5 On the campground, it is strictly forbidden to clean any vehicle using a hose. Camping equipment can only be washed with a pressure washer and only during low season.

3.6 Fires are allowed unless otherwise informed. They can only be lit in the fire pits. A constant watch over them is needed and they must be extinguished before leaving the area.

4.0 Departure

4.1 Campsites must be vacated by 1:00 p.m. The camper may re-register himself / herself before 11:00 a.m., however the same campsite might not be available.

4.2 The campsite must be left clean and in good shape.

4.3 If, for whatever reasons, a camper must leave his/her campsite before the departure date, no refunds are given (subject to the «Guaranteed Satisfaction Program»).

6.0 Miscellaneous

6.1 In general, it is forbidden to use someone else campsite.

6.5 Campers are subject to specific rules for the swimming pool.
